It's time for your region to submit nominations for the Credentials Committee.

Regions with a Texas REALTORS® Credentials Committee member and alternate that have terms expiring in 2026 shall elect individuals to fill a two-year term beginning December 1, 2026. For those regions that have members and alternates with terms expiring in 2027, it is not necessary to do anything at this time.

Regions 3, 4, 7, 11, and 14 will be electing members and alternates in 2026 to serve on the 2027-2028 Credentials Committee.

Applications are due 7.31.2026.

After staff receives an application, we will vet applicants in house and reach out to the applicant and the applicant's board. If there is more than one applicant per open position, Texas REALTORS staff will set up an election via Survey Monkey and share the results with the applicants and boards once completed. We have recently revised this process so please take a look at the materials below as well as a reference.

To be eligible to be elected to serve as a Committee Member, a person:

- i. Must be a REALTOR® member in good standing with their Member Board(s), Texas REALTORS®, and the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS® (NAR);
- ii. Cannot serve consecutive full two-year terms as a Committee Member;
- iii. Cannot have received formal discipline from the Texas Real Estate Commission for a violation that falls under Section 535.191(d) or (e) of the Texas Real Estate Commission rules within seven (7) years preceding the date of the election;
- iv. Cannot have been found in violation of NAR's Code of Ethics within three (3) years preceding the date of the election;
- v. Must have attended four (4) out of the last six (6) annual Texas REALTORS® meetings as set forth in Article VIII of the Texas REALTORS® Bylaws (self-certified); and (vi) Must have participated in Texas REALTORS® activities (e.g., served as

a Texas REALTORS® Director, Committee/Task Forces participation, etc.) in the last three (3) years; and

vi. Must have done at least one of the following:

- a. served at least one (1) year on their local Board of Directors; served at least one (1) year on the board of a qualified Institute, Society or Council affiliated with the National Association of REALTORS®; or
- b. served at least one (1) term as Regional Vice President of Texas REALTORS®.
