



Regional Vice Presidents (RVPs) Application and Election Process

Number: The number of Regional Vice Presidents from each region is based on the number of primary REALTOR® members in the region divided by 2,500, rounded to the nearest whole number not less than one. The number of members in each region is determined by the Texas REALTORS membership records on May 31 in the year preceding the election.

Eligibility: To be eligible for their election as a Regional Vice President the individual must meet eligibility requirements set forth in the [Texas REALTORS® Credentials Policy](#).

Nomination: Each local association within a region may submit one recommendation to the Credentials Committee for each available Regional Vice President position in the region. It is recommended that local associations make every attempt to reach a consensus on the most qualified candidate in their association and submit only that name for consideration. Please see the [list of the Texas REALTORS® regions and the number of Regional Vice Presidents each region is entitled](#). ***Local associations must submit their recommendation for Regional Vice President(s) to Texas REALTORS no later than December 2, 2025.*** The Credentials Committee will nominate one person per RVP position.

Election: The Board of Directors will elect the Regional Vice Presidents at the February meeting.

Terms: The two-year term begins on December 1 the year in which election and installation occur. With the exception of the single association regions, Regional Vice Presidents may not serve more than two, full consecutive two-year terms.
